Federal statute and federal regulations now govern train horn volume, pitch and duration in the United States of America.


Long Island Railroad train noise is unbearable.

Federal law permits lower train horn volume and pitch, shorter train horn sounding, lower bell volume, quieter wayside horns, "quiet zones" and "partial quiet zones."

The **Train Noise Abatement Association ("TNAA")**, a neighborhood association of nearly one thousand individuals interested in train noise abatement, has been working with federal, state, county, town and village officials to abate Long Island Railroad train noise.
